(Yamaska hang-gliding & paragliding club)

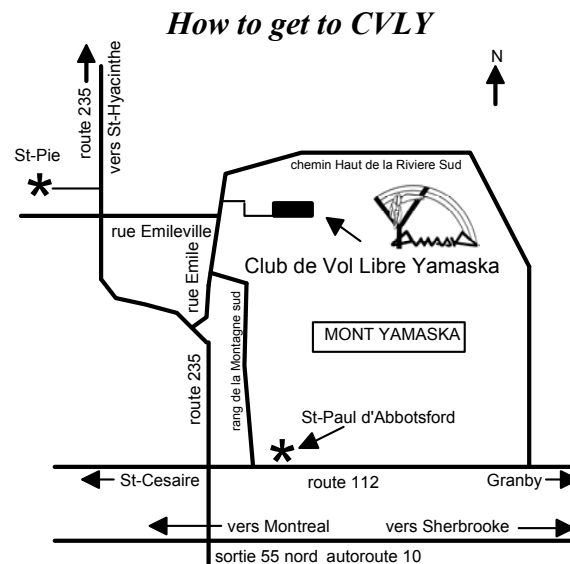
- 1978: First flights from Mount Yamaska and beginning of the Club activities.
- Run by pilots for pilots since its inception.
- The CVLY is a non-profit club run by officers democratically elected every year.
- In the past 20 years, the club has purchased its launch sites, access roads and main landing field, which makes the CVLY a unique hang-gliding/ paragliding club in North America.
- Over the years, the CVLY has obtained the official and legal recognition from all concerned authorities for the soaring activities on its sites, thus assuring long term survival of hang-gliding and paragliding at Mount Yamaska.

 - West to Southwest
- All launch sites can be reached with your 4X4, or with the **club shuttle** (\$6 per trip).
- Large, safe main landing area that can be reached from any of the club launch sites.
- Coaching program for new members and new pilots.
- “Wind-talker” reachable by phone which will give current conditions and trends for wind strength and direction.
- Roomy clubhouse to store your wing and equipment, with running water, electricity, phone, fridge, microwave, maps, etc.
- Rest area with picnic tables, BBQ, pool, shower, etc.
- Camping area amidst an apple orchard adjacent to the clubhouse where you and your family can rest after a full day of flying.
- Nanny service at reasonable rates (subject to availability).
